

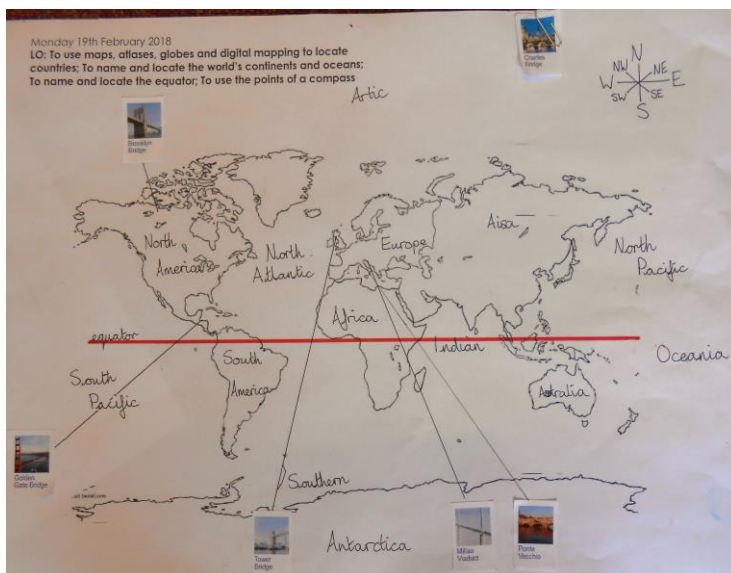
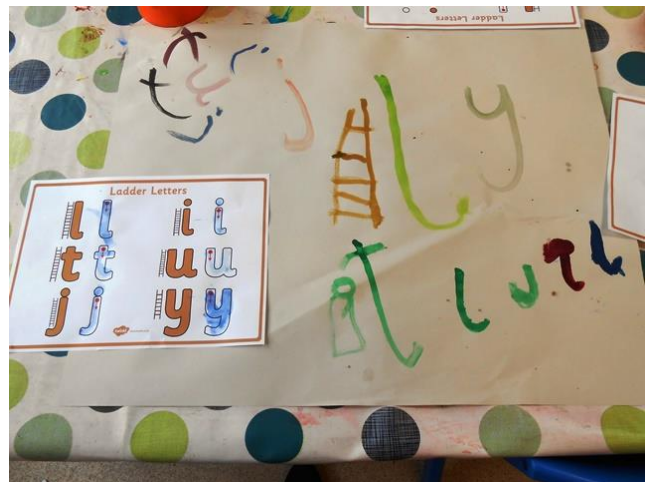
Weekly Newsletter
