Welcome back after half term! The children have come back refreshed and ready to learn and have already been very busy!

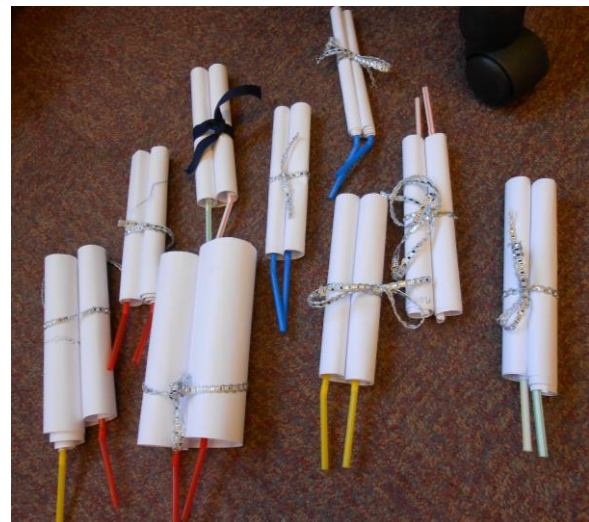
