# Bye Bye

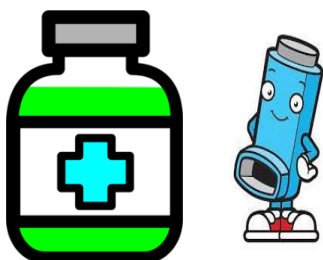


# Mrs Wood
