Pick one activity each week on Thursday and hand it in on Tuesday.

Choose a famous person from history, research them and create an information sheet/booklet about them.	If you were king/queen for the day, what 3 laws would you have and <i>why</i> ?	Design a stamp with your face on it.	Write a diary entry in role of a king/queen. <i>What have you done with your day?</i>
Research a king, queen or head of state from around the world and present your findings. (Yr3/4- not UK based)	In BFG, Roald Dahl refers to dreams. What is your dream? Present this with images as well as writing.	Show me what you know about symmetrical patterns... Then create your own!	Create 10 word problems based on addition and subtraction and the Royal family.
Illustrate your own family tree. Use drawings, collage, ICT, etc.	Design your own creature and its habitat. Remember to explain its features (E.g. long neck to reach leaves) <i>How is it adapted to its surroundings?</i>	Write instructions for how to make a new meal for a King or Queen. E.g. Royal Raison Tart, Special Spag Bol. <i>Why not make it?</i> (remember to get an adult to help you!)	Design a game for a Royal party.
