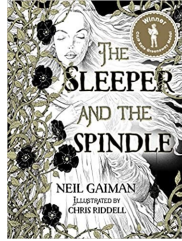


## Banksy Class Summer Term 1 2021 Curriculum Information for Parents

### ENGLISH

In English, we will be studying fairy tales with a twist! The first one, 'The Sleeper and Spindle' is a thrillingly reimagined fairy tale based on Snow White and Sleeping Beauty with a thread of dark magic. The class will be creating their own sequels or prequels to the book and will also have the opportunity to create a warning poster, diary entry, dialogue, an estate agent's property description, character descriptions and a missing narrative.



Our second text, 'The Lost Happy Endings' is a book about a witch who steals all the Happy Endings to traditional fairy tales and how the hero of the book recovers them. Whilst studying the book, the children will be writing a news report as well as creating a narrative from the perspective of the witch.



### MATHS

This half-term, in number, the children will continue to embed calculating using the four operations including calculating with fractions and decimals. We will recap on identifying equivalent fractions, decimals and percentages, as well as convert improper fractions to mixed numbers and simplify fractions. We will experience algebra by solving problems involving missing numbers, using formulas and interpreting number sequences. Year 6's will also be introduced to ratio and proportion and solve related word problems. In measure, we will focus on calculating and investigating area and perimeter. We will also solve problems involving converting different units of measure. In statistics, we will accurately draw graphs and charts.

### Foundation Subjects

In History, the children will be learning all about Earith and what makes our village so unique! We will study old and new photos and maps and identify the changes in the village over hundreds of years. The class will take part in fieldwork to identify important landmarks and historic buildings in the village and we will learn about our local history such as the 'Fen Tigers' and skaters on Bury Fen. In Science, we will learn about the three states of matter; be able to describe the water cycle and observe reversible and irreversible changes in materials. In R.E. our chosen religion is Islam and we will be specifically looking at Muhammad and his life and discussing why he is so important to Muslims. In PSHE, we will look at the importance of being assertive and discuss how to keep our bodies safe. In art, the class will be learning all about the Impressionist movement and creating artwork in the style of Claud Monet. In music, we will be learning how to sing the uplifting song- 'Happy' by Pharrell Williams and, in computing, the class will be practising their coding skills in order to create digital programmes.
