


ENGLISH

In English this term, we will start by looking at a variety of stories based on Goldilocks and the three bears. These stories include *Goldilocks and the Three Bears* by Lauren Child, *Me and You* by Anthony Browne and *Goldilocks and Just the One Bear* by Leigh Hodgkinson. We will look at letter writing, retelling the stories from both the bears and Goldilocks point of view, lists, character descriptions and instructions.

Later in the half term, we will look at *Jim and the Beanstalk* by Raymond Briggs where we will focus on narrative writing including dialogue.

MATHS

This term we will begin by learning more about numbers and the number system. We will be revising our knowledge of place value and then using this to help us when ordering numbers and solving addition and subtraction number problems. We will also be applying our skills to help us to solve word problems.

Later on we will move onto looking at money. We will be finding out about the value of coins and notes. We will look at how to make the same amount using different coins and notes. We will use our knowledge to work out total, find the difference and find change.

We will also cover work in measure, linking this with DT and the text *Jim and the Beanstalk*.

Tales with a Twist

We will start the half term with a short History topic on Guy Fawkes and the Gunpowder Plot.

In Science we will be investigating and exploring materials.

We will start off by considering the question "Did Goldilocks tell the truth?" and find out how the size of bowl affects the temperature of the porridge.

In Art we will be using Lauren Child's *Goldilocks and the three bears* as our inspiration to be creative and take photographs to create our own digital art.

In RE we will first study **Judaism** by looking at what and how Jews celebrate and then look at how **Christmas** is celebrated around the word. In PE we will be developing our football skills and multi-skills. In PSHCE we will look at our **emotions** and how we deal with them, as well as different types of **bullying** and strategies to deal with this. We will also continue to work closely on developing the children's **health and wellbeing**.
