Collect ideas (e.g. tiles, basins, bricks, roofing materials, pavements, kerbs, walls, etc). Write down why the particular rocks (or materials manufactured from rocks) have been used. E.g. <u>slate</u> for a roof - can be split easily into thin flat layers, waterproof; <u>marble</u> for a kitchen work surface - hard, not easily damaged, attractive.</p>

<p>Music Research a famous musician. Draw or print a picture of them and write facts around it.
